\$7.22 billion

Estimated amount of money generated by a 1% sales tax in the ten county region over a ten year period.



\$6.14 billion

85% of the funds to be used for regionally significant projects identified on the "investment list" by the Roundtable. May be located anywhere in the region.



\$1.08 billion

15% of the total funds raised are redistributed back to each jurisdiction (cities and counties) using a formula based on population and roadway mileage. This is not equivalent to "keeping" 15% of the funds generated.

To be selected at a later date. Funds may be used for any transportation related project, including maintenance, resurfacing, sidewalks, bicycle facilities, transit services and roadways.
